

WATERFORD SOUND HOA CAMERA USE POLICY

Guidelines for the operation of security cameras at the entrance of the subdivision.

The following will be considered general policy governing the use of recording Security cameras at the entrance/exit roads used by residents of Waterford Sound. The cameras are intended to deter criminal activity and to assist Law Enforcement authorities conducting investigations.

- Two cameras will be installed to record vehicles or pedestrians entering the property (pointed toward the road) and two additional cameras will be installed to document vehicles or pedestrians exiting the subdivision. All cameras will be mounted in a secure manner on the outside of the middle lighthouse or tower. A Digital Video Recorder (DVR) connected to the cameras will be installed inside the lighthouse or tower. The DVR is designed to record activity for 14-30 days.
- The use of recorded data will be limited to law enforcement officials. Any other requests for disclosure will be at the discretion of the HOA Board. No recording is intended for the private use of any resident or other person.
- Access to the recorded data will be determined by the HOA Board. This access is intended to quickly provide the information to Law Enforcement in the event of the commission of a crime.
